



TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Big Brown Box: The 7PM Project Promotion

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia. However, employees and their immediate families of Network TEN Pty Ltd and Beinteractive Pty Ltd, and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
3. The competition commences on Monday, 14th December 2009 at 00:01 AEDT and concludes on Friday, 18th December 2009 at 23:59 AEDT.
4. To enter, participants must send a text/SMS message to 1999 1111 or log onto www.ten.com.au or www.7pmproject.com.au and register their details including (but not limited to) name, address, phone number, e-mail address and the relevant daily codeword. Entries to the SMS number must include the entrant's full name, full address, state and relevant daily codeword SMS entrants will receive a reply message. The daily codewords will be advertised on Network TEN during The 7PM Project program for the duration of the promotion.
5. The SMS entry mechanic is only open to consumers with a SMS compatible mobile phone connected to a service provider which permits text messaging to the promotional SMS number. It is recommended that entrants check with their individual service provider in this regard.
6. Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the prior permission of a parent or guardian over the age of 18 to enter.
7. Incomprehensible and incomplete entries will be deemed invalid.
